

Traditional OCR vs Parchment Receive, Data Automation



Traditional OCR







Consuming Transcripts As Data: Implementation Overview



Typical Project	4-6 weeks
Install	Usually a few days, since in the Cloud and only need to establish connectivity
Customer Testing	Customer testing, training, DEV, and getting comfortable before moving to PROD (TBD)
Batch Mode	Potentially 6-8 additional weeks
Custom	If any customization determined at scope, timeline TBD
