The California Community Colleges Transfer Guarantee Agreement to HBCUs is a transfer pathway to participating HBCUs that started in 2015. In the most recent MOU updates, the California Community Colleges Transfer Guarantee Agreement to HBCUs has established transfer pathways utilizing transfer level associate degrees and corresponding Bachelor degree programs. 
